

To support self-correction behavior:

- ◆ Something wasn't quite right.
- ◆ Try that again
- ◆ I liked the way you worked that out.
- ◆ You made a mistake. Can you find it?
- ◆ You're nearly right. Try that again.

To support phrased, fluent reading:

- ◆ Can you read that quickly?
- ◆ Put your words together so it sounds like talking.
- ◆ Read the punctuation.
- ◆ Make your voice go down when you see the period.
- ◆ Make your voice go up when you see the question mark.
- ◆ Take a short breath when you see the comma or dash.
- ◆ Use emphasis when you see the exclamation mark.
- ◆ Make it sound like the characters are talking.
- ◆ Set off the parentheses by stopping before and after them.
- ◆ Read it like this (Model phrase units).
- ◆ Read this much all together (cover part of print to expose the phrase unit).
- ◆ Make your voice show what you would say in a normal conversation.
