- School Improvement Plan for 2021-2022 school year
 - Reading Goal: By the end of the 2020 - 2021 school year, the percent of students in grade 1 - 3 performing on grade level or making typical progress in reading will increase
 - Math Goal: By the end of the 2020 - 2021 school year, the percent of mathematics students in grades 3 - 6 performing on grade level or making typical progress in math will increase
- I-Ready math and reading licenses will need to be purchased for next year for each child
 - 6th grade will be in Jr. High next year, so the cost of I-Ready licenses will be less
- What is the best use of TSSA funds for next year?
 - Professional development
 - Send teachers to virtual conference - \$1,500/school for all teachers to attend
 - Chromebook charging carts being replaced as needed, same with Chromebook devices
 - Expected to replace around 50 Chromebooks/year
 - We have charging carts for the Chromebooks in every classroom
 - Replacing older Chromebooks with touch screen Chromebooks
 - Audio enhancement is being replaced in classrooms as well (voted on this last month)
 - Equipment - about 10 monitors need to be replaced in the school
